Hello Everyone,

Another month has flown by, and as we jump into November it's a reminder that we have only 8 Fridays till Christmas.

At this stage Residents Christmas parties will go ahead at Hillside, however guests and families are yet to be determined if they are invited, as this is reliant on the directive from NSW Health.

Our Christmas party dates are 9th and 10th December 2020. Thank you to everyone who continues to their bit in helping us out with following the guidance on visitation.

All visits will continue with 2 persons to each resident's, 7 days a week 9-5pm. All visits will continue to be in residents' room or on the balcony in Mitchell. No booking is required for residents' room; however, we ask that you book in with the Lifestyle Officer should you wish to utilise the Mitchel Balcony area.

Reason being seatings are limited and we will need to adhere to the social distancing rule. It remains necessary to supply vaccination copies if you have not done so, and to please comply with our entry requirements of taking temperatures, answering our health questions.

It is the directive of the NSW Health that visitors living in the "hot spot" area will not be allowed in the facility until further notice. We do apologise in advance should you not be able to visit for this reason, but we are only following the direction of NSW Health. Being vigilant with social distancing, wearing masks, gowns and washing/sanitising your hands is imperative in keeping the home Covid free.

Please note that the wearing of the face mask is not mandatory if you have a face shield, HOWEVER we understand that residents often have difficulty hearing you through the face mask, thus we thought it would benefit residents when conversing with them with a face shield in place. You can then place the
